- Oversee the preparation of engineering documentation to ensure that drawings, N/C programs, BOMs etc., are available in a timely and efficient manner. Ensure the accuracy of all documentation generated by the department.
- Responsible for promoting and maintaining compliance to ISO 9000 and ensure that employees understand what their role in ISO is and how it relates to each of their duties.
